Elementary Program Overview

Curriculum

Rock Creek students average scores at each grade on the nationally normed Terra Nova Achievement Test ranged from the 83rd to the 98th percentile. This is well above the national average of the 50th percentile. The elementary curriculum holds students to the highest standards and challenges all students to use their God-given abilities to achieve their learning potential. The elementary language arts and mathematics programs foster critical thinking and life application. Language arts is centered on a strong foundation in phonics, and explicit instruction in comprehension and writing. Mathematics instruction is focused on developing conceptual understanding, procedural knowledge, and problem solving skills.

Special Areas

All students participate in six special areas each week consisting of Art, Music, Library, Computer, Physical Education and Spanish.

Academic Enrichment opportunities include ACSI competitions in Creative Writing, Spelling Bee, and Math Olympics. Extracurricular activities are offered throughout the year. Spilled Ink Society, a club for our budding authors, is one example.

Fine Arts

Educational opportunities are also available through fine arts programs such as Hand Chimes, Ukulele, Music Club and Fifth Grade Band. Field trips to local theatre performances, community events, and museums are conducted throughout the year.



Physical

Developing a healthy lifestyle is a focus for the Rock Creek community. We believe growing in stature is more than mere physical growth. Students understand they are created in the image of God and are responsible for making healthy living choices. Students participate in Physical Education class and Intramural Sports programs. The Intramural Sports program for students in grades 1-5 includes football, cross country, soccer, volleyball, basketball, cheerleading, and tennis.

Spiritual

Weekly Chapel services and daily Bible instruction contribute to each child's development of a Biblical worldview and a personal love for Jesus Christ. Rock Creek staff believes that growing in favor with God and men is more than Bible study. It is applying God's word where students participate in age appropriate local and global service opportunities.

Social

Rock Creek's unique environment in the heart of St. Matthews promotes a "small town feeling". Families develop deep friendships during their children's years at Rock Creek. There are many opportunities for parents and grandparents to become involved: Christmas at CAL Family Festival, Field Day, Evening Reading Events, Skating Parties, and the Father/Daughter and Mother/Son Socials are just a few examples.
