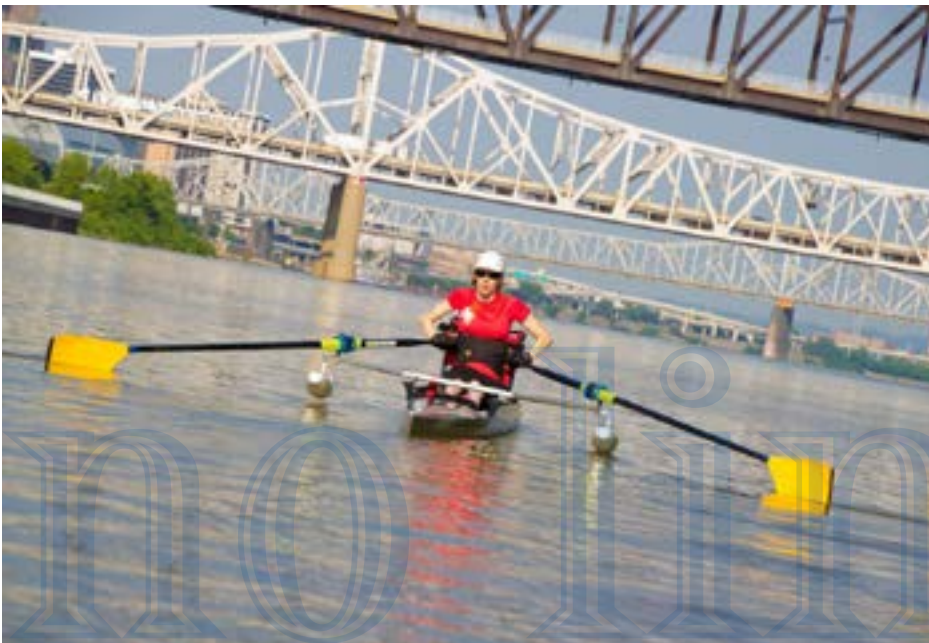

While practicing with the CAL cheerleading squad in Seneca Park she was performing a familiar routine when she slipped and fell injuring herself. She sustained a C6-7 spinal cord injury. That translated into the loss of her hands and being paralyzed from the chest down. Ten months later she graduated from Christian Academy and started at the University of Louisville. While there she received her Bachelor's degree in Psychology and Religious Studies. Her masters is in Counseling and Psychology. Employed by JCPS to work as a teacher for the English as a Second Language Program she worked with K- 5th grade students. Jenny has worked to distribute wheelchairs in destinations such as N. Africa and Afghanistan, she is also a peer mentor at Frazier Rehab for those just starting their journey after therapy for life changing accidents. She volunteers at the Refuge Ministry helping with



English in the park for the refugees. She loves to play tennis, read, and research family history. Jenny is also a member of the Louisville Rowing Club, which she enjoys because of the freedom it allows her to feel separate from her wheelchair. What most impacted me in the time spent with her for this article is that she is a woman who has accomplished more in her life than most people ever start to do and with her eyes firmly fixed on Christ there is doubt she has many more items on her agenda.

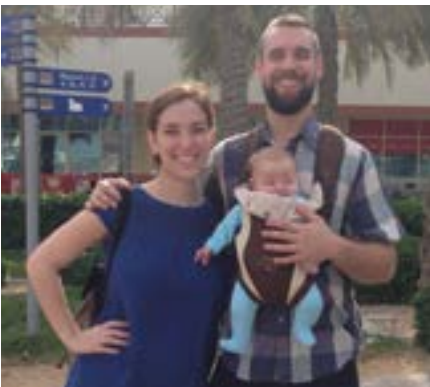
JOHN HAMILTON '07

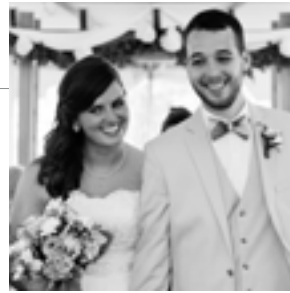
