Program Highlights

The Rock Creek Junior Academy program is dedicated to the educational and spiritual development of our students. Our Christian teachers offer an environment that is loving, supportive, and recognizes each child as a precious gift created by God.

Our priority is to prepare children for a seamless transition to Kindergarten. To accomplish this, the curriculum is structured around key areas such as phonics, math, and handwriting.

The following curriculum is currently being used:

- ABEKA Phonics
- Handwriting Without Tears
- Scripture Bites

Enrichment programs are offered in music and library. Pre-K classes visit the Elementary special area teachers for these weekly enrichment opportunities. Younger students participate in these activities during classroom instruction. God's Word is emphasized for all ages, through Bible stories and songs during a weekly chapel service.

For parents, we encourage involvement and participation in our active Parent Teacher Organization (PTO).

The Rock Creek Junior Academy is licensed by the State of Kentucky and a recognized member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

Program Options

- Enrollment is open for children between the ages of 2-4 (children 3 years and older; potty training is highly encouraged but not required for enrollment)
