Bus Service is provided for Kindergarten through 12th Grade.

Times are approximate, depending on traffic conditions. Due to road, traffic & weather conditions, please have your child at the bus stop at least 5 minutes early. Bus drivers cannot wait past scheduled departure time.

Exact location of bus stops within the parking lots is at the discretion of the bus driver based upon local conditions and safety considerations.

There can be no stops other than those listed.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

The bus schedule is reviewed periodically and adjustments are made based on participation. A continuous effort is made to promote increased ridership. Schedule is subject to revision after September. Please check website for most current schedule.

BUS RULES

Our chief concern is to ensure the safety of each rider. If the driver is distracted by a discipline problem, he may be endangering all of the students. For this reason, we give our strong support to the rules the bus company requests each rider observe:

1. Bus ID tags should be **visibly** attached to purse or backpack.
2. Cooperate with and respect the driver.
3. Observe the same conduct rules as in the classroom.
4. Do not eat or drink on the bus.
5. Do not use cellphones or other electronic devices on the bus.
6. No animals are permitted on the bus.
7. Keep the bus clean.
8. Stay in your seat.
9. Keep head, hands, and feet inside the bus.

BUS COSTS, DAILY USAGE

Bus fee is due on or before the first of each month, September to May.

A \$10 late charge will be assessed for payments not received as scheduled. Bus service will be suspended for accounts two months past due. In the event your student withdraws from daily bus service, your monthly payments will continue until the Business Office is notified and bus tag is returned.

PARENTS OF DAILY RIDERS MUST COMPLETE A CONSENT FORM ON RENWEB TO USE BUS SERVICE.

BUS COSTS, OCCASIONAL USAGE

Occasional bus riders are individual students who will use bus service 10 times or less during a monthly period.

Occasional bus riders must pay the Business Office \$5 per ride (\$5 in a.m./\$5 in p.m.) and obtain a pass PRIOR to riding the bus. Bus passes are given to driver upon boarding the bus.

PARENTS OF OCCASIONAL RIDERS MUST COMPLETE A CONSENT FORM ON RENWEB TO USE BUS SERVICE. THE CONSENT FORM MAY BE COMPLETED ONCE AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT THE ENTIRE YEAR.
