Parenting Insights with Dr. Black

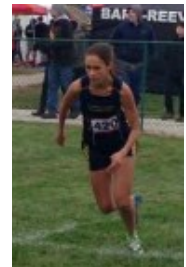

The Boys Cross Country team made history Saturday as the only class 1A team competing in the State Finals in Terre Haute and the first ever boys team to compete in a State Finals. The team competed well and ended up being the 11th best team out of every single High School in the state of Indiana! Skylar Stidam and Caleb Futter raced with the leaders and ended up a fantastic 3rd place and 6th place respectively. This made them the third fastest duo from any school in State Meet history. The rest of the boys finished strong to complete an amazing season and help this team place so high. They end the season as the 11th ranked team overall and the top Class 1A team. In the girls race, McKenna Cavanaugh continued to make history of her own by competing in her 3rd straight Cross Country State Championship. Her determination and grit pushed her to a finish of 54th in the State.

Cold Weather Dress Code Reminders-

- **Shoes** - Standard athletic/tennis shoes (**no light-up**), secured tightly on feet with laces or Velcro, should be worn with socks visible above the shoe. Solid navy, black, or brown dress shoes with socks or tights, may be worn on chapel days but are not required. If students have P.E. on chapel day, they will need to bring tennis shoes and socks. Dress shoes are not permitted on the gym floor. **No boots, platform shoes, sandals, clogs, backless or slip-on shoes are permitted at any time.**
- **Coats/Jackets** - These may not be worn in the classroom.
- **Classroom approved sweaters/sweatshirts/jackets** – Navy or white cardigans or navy crew or v-neck sweaters may be worn in the classroom. Only sweatshirts approved for uniform dress may be worn with a collared shirt or turtleneck. A royal blue fleece jacket and royal blue ¼ zip are approved uniform dress that are only available at Shaheen’s. While pride wear is fun to own and wear, it is not approved for dress code.
- **Shirts** - Solid navy, white or gold polo shirts with short or long sleeves must be worn. These should be tucked in at the waist. (Gold polo with CAI logo are to be worn for all field trips.) Navy or white turtlenecks may be worn under a sweatshirt, jumper, or sweater for cold weather. Turtlenecks may not be worn as outerwear.
- **Socks or tights** - Solid navy or white socks or tights may be worn (**no designs, lace, or ruffles**). Socks should be **visible above the shoe**. If leggings are worn for warmth, socks and leggings should overlap so no skin is showing.
