HS/MS Drop Off/Pick Up Procedures:

- Student drop off and pick up are at the Gym/Fine Arts doors; please do not drop off or pick up at the HS/MS front office door.
- In the mornings, parents may pull up alongside the curb at the Gym/Fine Arts doors to drop off students or may park in a space, whichever is preferred.
- After school, we ask that drivers do not pull alongside the curb, but only park in the Gym/Fine Arts lot to wait for their student to come

Parents, grandparents, aunts/uncles, and adult siblings are always welcome to come have lunch with their student; we also welcome youth pastors and pastors to come visit with students at lunch.
