Traffic Reminders

Elementary Morning Drop-Off Reminders:

- Students should be ready to exit the car as soon as the car stops.
- Drivers, please pull up as far forward as you can before stopping.
- Drivers, please stay in your car; the staff and patrol guards are there to assist your child.
- Pedestrians should cross only at the main crosswalk.
- The speed limit is 15 mph on campus.

Prescheduled Family Vacations

If it is necessary for a family to keep a student from attending school for a family trip or vacation, the following procedure is to be followed:

- Notify the teacher and building administration in writing at least two weeks in advance of the dates the student will miss. Work will be given to the student on the last day of their attendance before leaving on the trip.
- The administration will contact the teacher and identify the impact of the student missing those specific dates. Please avoid scheduling vacations at the end of a grading period and during ILEARN, IREAD, or standardized testing.
- All missed work should be turned in upon the day of return. Students **will** be prepared to make up tests at the teacher's discretion.

Perfect Attendance

A certificate of perfect attendance is awarded to any student who attends school all day every day of the school year. If a student has five or more tardies and/or early dismissals, he/she will not be eligible for a perfect attendance award. Students must be **in their classroom** by 8:00 to not be tardy.

Emergency Contact and Pick Ups

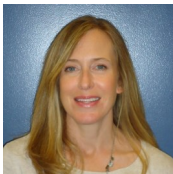
Please make sure your information in your RenWeb account is current. Please confirm Emergency Contacts and Pick Ups (those persons you permit to pick up your child). If someone comes to pick up your child that is not on your list, they will be asked to show identification and you will be called. Please communicate with your child's teacher if there is a new person picking up your child.

Before and After Care

In order for your child to attend either Before or After Care, you must go into your RenWeb account and complete the Before or After Care registration form. There is no fee to register your child. If the form is not completed by the second time your child uses Before or After Care, your child will not be able to stay and you will be contacted to come and pick them up immediately.
