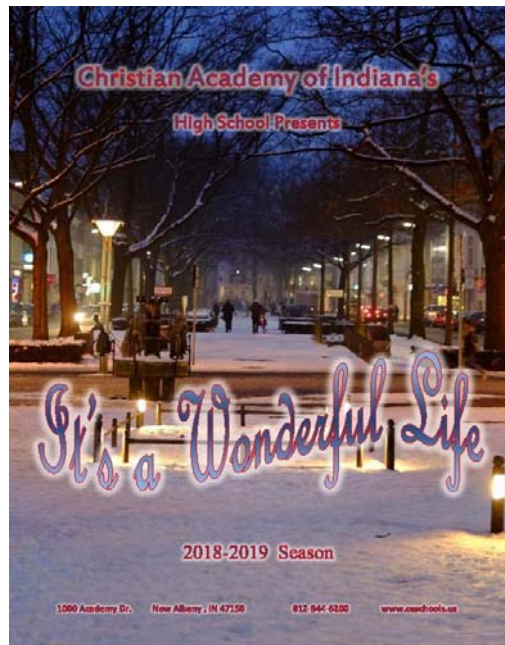
## School Closed-Thanksgiving
