When: TONIGHT, Friday, November 9, at 7:00 pm 

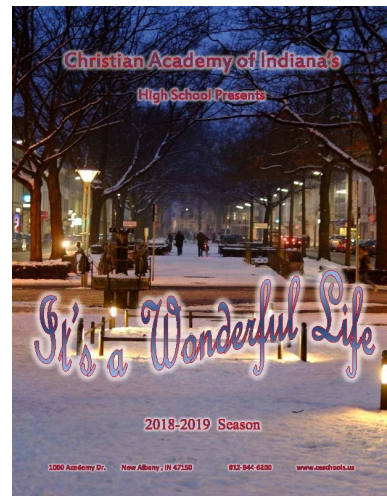
Where: CAI Gymnasium

- School –Age Care and Full Day Junior Academy:
  - \*Closed when the rest of the school is closed.
  - \*Will open at the regular time if there is a two-hour delay.
