Required for All Elementary Grades

Middle School Locker Guidelines

Students will be given the opportunity to decorate and organize their lockers at Back-to-School Drop-In on Monday, August 12

- Students must use the lock and locker assigned by the school office.
- Locker dimensions: 11 ¾" wide and 10" deep
- Decorations on the outside of the lockers are not permitted.
- Personal family photos are allowed.
- Magnetic mirrors, dry erase boards, and organizer shelves are allowed. The cloth hanging shelves work best.
- Only magnets are allowed - no tape or other adhesives.
- Contact paper/wallpaper is not allowed.
- Magazine pictures, posters, stickers, slogans, or album covers are not allowed.
- Books must be stored vertically in the locker (standing).
