High School Sports

The Christian Academy of Louisville Centurions participate in 22 sports during three seasons. The Centurion Athletic Complex includes fields for baseball, field hockey, football, soccer, softball and track & field; two gymnasiums; and a weight room. Spring Sports: baseball, lacrosse, softball, tennis and track & field.
