School Closure

Families,

Governor Beshear of Kentucky and Governor Holcomb of Indiana have suggested that all public and private schools close for a period of several weeks beginning Monday. We are going to follow that suggestion. That means that our Kentucky campuses will be closed from Monday, March 16, through April 5 (which includes the week of spring break). School will resume on April 6. Our Indiana campus is off for their spring break beginning March 16, and we are going to close that campus for an additional week after spring break so they will also resume school on April 6, as well.

All campuses will provide instruction to our students during the times that they would normally have been in school, either electronically or by some other means that will be communicated by the principals or the classroom teachers. Please be patient with us as we coordinate the details of this with the teachers. All regularly scheduled activities will go on through this Saturday unless you hear differently from your principal. Otherwise, all school activities are cancelled between March 16, and April 5.

For those of you who have Junior Academy (preschool) children, we have decided to keep all of our Junior Academy classes open during this entire time. As always, you have the option of keeping your children home if you so desire.

Our campuses will remain open (except during spring break) and <u>our teachers will be available by email to help with instructions and answer questions.</u>

More information will be sent as we work through more of the details with principals and teachers tomorrow, but we want to give you as much advance notice as possible so that you can make preparations and arrangements involving the next three weeks.

Even though this has been difficult to deal with, we want to continue to partner with you to provide the best service and education possible despite an unpredictable and challenging time.

God is still in control and this is a good opportunity to have conversations with our children about how to deal with those unexpected and difficult life circumstances that are beyond our control.
