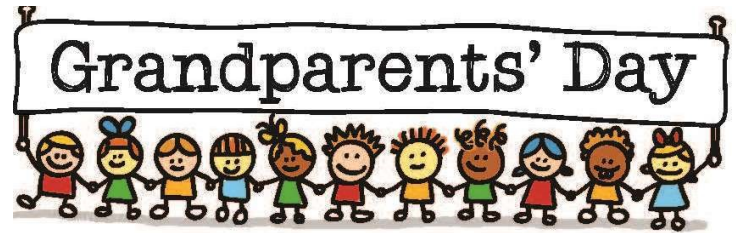

## Grandparents' Day Information

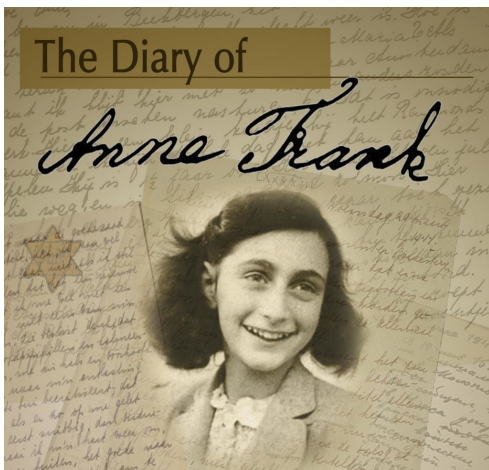
Thursday, September 19, and Friday, September 20
