In a rivalry match that saw the Lions climb their way back into the first two sets to keep them close and the Warriors winning both on a couple late service runs, CAI came out on fire in the 3rd set and capped off a 3-0 victory. The Warriors finished the night with 15 team aces, 30 kills (17 from **Kendall Kerberg**), 6 blocks, 26 assists, and 47 digs. Thursday saw the varsity team back in action at home for only the 2nd time this season, facing off against a solid Trinity Lutheran team. The Warriors remained competitive through all three sets, making some pretty incredible plays to keep rallies going. However, the offensive fire power and serving of Trinity Lutheran proved to be too much in the end for the Warriors. On Saturday, CAI traveled out west to the Barr-Reeve Invite and played in four highly competitive matches, dropping all four matches. It was great competition for the Warriors and will help prepare them long run for the postseason. *A big milestone in the varsity career of **Kendall Kerberg** was reached in the Saturday match vs. Tecumseh. With her 2nd kill of the match, Kerberg moved into elite Warrior company, surpassing 1,000 career kills. **Kerberg** totaled 61 kills on the day and senior **Halle Rankin** had 55 assists.
