

Christian Academy School System

Tuition Assistance

- FACTS Grant and Aid application's open in January and are due on the date listed on the School System website. First-round award decisions will go out the first week of May.
- FACTS requires a non-refundable application fee of \$30; please allow 2 weeks for processing.
- Copies of the following documents are required to complete your FACTS application and must be uploaded to your application or faxed to FACTS.
 - All W-2's are required for both the applicant and co-applicant.
 - Current Federal Tax Return for both the applicant and co-applicant (1040 – 1040A – 1040 EZ)
 - Additional applicable schedules: Schedule C or C-EZ (Business Income); Schedule D (Capital Gains); Schedule E (Supplemental Income).
 - All business tax returns, such as K1s, 1120s for S Corporation, 1065s for Partnership, and 8825.
- Qualifying candidate's tuition assistance application may be reviewed by School Choice of Kentucky or School Choice of Indiana. To learn more, please click the link provided on the main tuition assistance page.
- All families are required to complete the FACTS Grant and Aid application and supply updated documentation on an annual basis for review.
- A tuition assistance application will not be reviewed by the Tuition Assistance Committee until a student is accepted into Christian Academy and the family's FACTS Grant and Aid application is verified and complete. It is a family's responsibility to provide FACTS, not Christian Academy, with the required documents.
- Tuition assistance awards are based on a family's need, applicant pool, and school budget.
- Tuition assistance awards may be adjusted each year according to changes to a family's financial situation and the School System's tuition budget. The School System cannot guarantee future awards will always be higher (or even the same) as the previous year's award.
- Applying for tuition assistance does not guarantee that a family will be eligible for assistance.
- Families who submit late applications or requests for assistance will receive awards based on any remaining funds.
- Christian Academy reserves the right to alter, adjust or revoke any tuition assistance award that was based on inaccurate, false or incomplete information.
- Christian Academy expects that families will not share their financial assistance information with other families. Awards may be withdrawn due to breach of this confidentiality.
