- Elementary boys- Dress shirts or polos with dress pants or school uniform bottoms. No t-shirts or jeans. (Ties are optional.)
- Elementary girls- Modest dresses no shorter than 2 inches above the knee with sleeves or nice tops with dress pants (no jeans) or skirts no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Leggings may be worn under a dress or skirt, but the dress or skirt must still be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. If a dress or top is sleeveless, it must be worn with a sweater. Girls may wear sandals for their picture, but must bring tennis shoes to change into.
