He was nominated by the Security Forces Squadron for Airman of the Year earlier in 2014. While Kenny did not receive the award, the nomination by itself is an honor. He was awarded an Achievement Medal for saving a young woman's life when he intervened during a dispute with her boyfriend that had turned violent. Using his Security Forces experience he subdued the offender, administered first aid to the victim and safeguarded the area until local law enforcement officers arrived on the scene. His actions potentially saved her



life. Ben is in the Air Force ROTC at the University of Louisville and just started his third year. Upon successful completion of the program he will go on active duty in the United States Air Force when he graduates. We are proud to recognize these CAL Alumni!

### **ALLISON FOSTER, CLASS OF 2012**



Foster named Great Lakes Valley Conference Player of the Year Ally Foster was honored at the 2014 Great Lakes Valley Conference Softball Championship Tournament banquet as the conference's Player of the Year. She was selected as the POY and first-team All-GLVC East as a utility player. Before leading Bellarmine into the GLVC Softball Championship, Foster built what may have been an irrevocable case to become the league's POY. Name a statistical category offensively, and the Louisville native either heads the GLVC or is among the leaders. Foster plays center field when she's not pitching, and leads the league in batting average (.397), slugging percentage (.747) and on-base percentage (.508), and is top seven in hits (58), doubles (15), homers (12), RBIs (36), runs scored (39), total bases (109) and walks (31).

Foster has been just as dominating when she leaves the batter's box for the pitcher's circle. Her anemic 0.92 ERA is fifth in the country, and she's second in the nation in hits allowed per seven innings (2.81). The overpowering right-hander has struck out a BU single-season record of 172 batters while accumulating a 16-5 record with a GLVC-best four saves. Opponents are batting a paltry .123 against the two-time All-GLVC first teamer, which leads the conference.

### **MEGAN LAFFOON, CLASS OF 2012**

WKU student, Megan Laffoon, was recognized by the Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship and Excellence in Education Program.

Laffoon, the daughter of Jeannie and Glen Laffoon, is a biology major who plans to graduate in 2016. She is a student in the Honors College at WKU and the Chinese Flagship Program and is traveling this summer to Taiwan for an intensive Chinese language program. Her goals include earning a PhD in conservation ecology and conducting research in environmental restoration.

Laffoon is combining her love of the Chinese language with a desire to make a difference by studying ways to combat the problem of karst desertification in China caused by deforestation, according to her mentors, Biology Professor Dr. Albert Meier and Geography and Geology Professor Dr. Chris Groves. Dr. Meier said the problem impacts millions of people by creating problems with water supply and agriculture through soil erosion.

"Finding solutions to these problems in an active area of research within China and learning about it was immediately appealing to Megan," he said. "There is an obvious nexus between her interests in envi-



ronmental science and China, and there was a special appeal to her clear sense of wanting to work in applied studies that might actually make a difference in helping people and somehow improving quality of life, and all of these elements were present."

Dr. Meier said Laffoon is "intelligent, creative and curious, but this would not have been enough if she had not shown the spirit of caring and giving that has inspired her work, and the preparation that allowed her to recognize and make the most of opportunities."
