Developing a healthy lifestyle is a focus for the Rock Creek community. Students participate in Physical Education class and Intramural Sports programs. The Intramural Sports program for students in grades 1-5 includes football, cross country, soccer, volleyball, basketball, cheerleading and tennis.

The Rock Creek Distinctive

The Rock Creek campus provides a unique learning environment stimulating academic, social and spiritual growth. The open campus provides learning "brain breaks" which invigorate senses and learning capability. The integration of our Providence School for students with Down syndrome promotes appreciation of God's unique design and how we encourage others. Our Sensory Gym offers therapeutic techniques to address physical and academic challenges. The small class size and intimate teaching style allow individual attention to develop each student's gifts to their highest potential.

Elementary Program Overview

Curriculum

Rock Creek students' average scores at each grade on the nationally normed Terra Nova Achievement Test are well above the national norm. The elementary curriculum holds students to the highest standards and challenges all students to use their God-given abilities to achieve their learning potential. The elementary language arts and mathematics programs foster critical thinking and life application. Language arts create a strong foundation in phonics and explicit instruction in comprehension and writing. Mathematics, STEM programs (beginning in kindergarten), our Sensory Gym, and Collaboratory Lab all help develop conceptual understanding, creativity and problem solving skills.

Special Areas

All students participate in six special areas each week: Art, Music, Library, Computer, Physical Education and Spanish.

Academic Enrichment opportunities include ACSI competitions in Creative Writing, Spelling Bee and Math Olympics. Extracurricular activities include Chapel Praise Team, Hebrew School, Mission Club, Tech Team, Techies in Training and Robotics Team.

Fine Arts

Music and Art classes are complemented by the Drama Club, Performance Hand Chimes and Mallets, Recorder Club, Ukuele and 4th & 5th Grade Band. Field trips include local theatre performances, community events and museums. Private lessons are available for guitar, voice and piano.



Rock Creek was the only elementary school in Louisville awarded the U.S. Department of Education National Blue Ribbon School Award for academic excellence in 2012. Our STEM Program was recognized as a National Launch School in 2016.



Christian Academy School System administers Measures of Academic Progress to help assess and enhance elementary and middle school reading and math proficiency. Christian Academy students in grades K-8 consistently score above the national average on standardized tests.
