## CAL GAINS REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP OUTLASTING THE SCOTTIES OF GLASGOW, 28-20



On a cold and dank Fri night @ Hank Royce Stadium in Glasgow, KY, the 6-2 Centurions withstood their toughest defensive opponent to date, the 7-2 Scotties of Glasgow in the 3A Regional Championships, posting a nail-biting 28-20 victory. Their overall record goes to 2-1 vs Glasgow. The 7-2 Centurions advance to the 3A Semifinals where their 9<sup>th</sup> RPI ranking will go up against the Top-Rated team in 3A, the Elizabethtown panthers, 11-0.

As in the Mercer Co game, the Centurions surrendered the first points in the half going down 6-0 after a missed PAT. CAL would rebound behind the Masters to Messer connection and there were a flurry of 3 TDs within the last 1:30 of the half creating a 21-12 halftime advantage for CAL. In the second half, CAL's D remained solid with their only bugaboo being able to stop the Scotties' #14, J. Long. CAL also began chewing clock utilizing Brandt Babin on the ground at a near 5yd/ carry clip. After a late TD by Glasgow, CAL forced a critical turnover allowing for Brandt Babin's last TD, albeit allowed by the Glasgow D, accounting for the 28-20 margin. The game went down to the wire and Kudos to the O and D lines who were up to the task.
