CAL 76 Bullitt East 84, January 12, 2021

This game was even through three quarters before East pulled away with two minutes left. George Washington paced the Centurions with 29 points and 4 assists. George hit 6 of 10 three pointers. Senior Brayden Daniels hit 19 points, 4 rebounds, and 3 assists. Senior Stephen Wearsch had 10 points and 8 rebounds. Senior Tyler Lagestee hit half of his 3 pointers on the way to 9 points and 2 assists. CAL shot 49% from the floor, and 50% from beyond the arc.



CAL 88 Trinity 94, 2OT, January 14, 2021

What a heartbreaker. CAL almost took down the giant Shamrock squad at home, falling just short in two overtimes. A slow start found our boys down 11 points after the first quarter. But we turned it around in the second and third quarters. Hot shooting, as usual, kept CAL in the game. Overall, we shot 53% from the floor, led by Wearsch (8 of 10), Daniels (7 of 14), and senior Conner Haun (4 of 6). Daniels dropped 21 points (5 three pointers), 5 assists, and 2 steals. Wearsch scored 19 points with 5 rebounds. Washington had another solid night scoring 19 with 6 assists. Haun had 10 and 3. Lagestee scored 7 points with 3 rebounds and 3 assists. Erhardt scored 9.

CAL 79 DeSales 85, January 16, 2021

Another game that could have gone either way, CAL was up by 4 with six minutes to play and just couldn't hold on. DeSales benefitted from two new transfer players, both of whom are division 1 prospects. 6'8" 220 lb. center Kalle from overseas and point guard Devin Perry. Kalle and Perry accounted for 60% of DeSales points. Coach Aaron Hill had a plan though, foul out Kalle...and it mostly worked. Wearsch and Daniels took turns guarding big Kalle. Daniels took pride in his defense using his athletic ability to deny Kalle the ball, deflecting and tipping multiple passes by DeSales to get the ball in the paint. Wearsch ended Kalle's night in dramatic fashion. CAL inbounded the ball with an alley-oop to Wearsch who caught the ball and scored mid-air with Kalle fouling him. Kalle went to the bench for the night and Wearsch completed the 3 point play. DeSales guard Perry proved too much down the stretch, though, scoring 3 or 4 baskets in the last two minutes to ice the game. This CAL team never gives up and is so much fun to watch. Conner Haun's hustle play once again set the tone for the game. He had 12 points (50% shooting), 5 rebounds, 3 cuts, and 4 bruises. Wearsch had 20 points (64% shooting), 8 rebounds, and 6 assists. Washington scored 20 points with 4 assists. Daniels had 5 points, 4 rebounds, 2 steals, and 3 assists. Luke Erhardt scored 16 points (50%) with 4 rebounds. Seven Centurions scored three pointers including all the above listed players plus Tyler Lagestee and Cole Hodge.

CAL's record stands at 2-4.

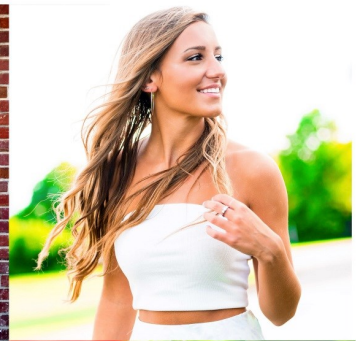
