VARSITY BOYS BASKETBALL NOTCHES ANOTHER HUGE WIN *ENDS JOHN HARDIN'S 36 GAME HOME WINNING STREAK*

Just a week after knocking off big school Bardstown for its first marquee win of the season, CAL scored its biggest win of the year so far by knocking off #12 and previously undefeated John Hardin at their place 72-70 Friday night. Coach Aaron Hill's program took a giant leap forward with this victory. Eyebrows were most certainly raised across the state with the result of this game.



Hill's Centurions are becoming a force to be reckoned with across the Kentucky high school basketball landscape. Let's put this in perspective. John Hardin had won 36 home games in a row dating back to December 2016. John Hardin is the back to back defending 2A state basketball champions. Captain Stephen Wearsch had another stellar performance. The senior nailed 71% of his shots scoring 22 points. He also had 5 rebounds, 2 blocks, and 3 assists. John Hardin could not stop Wearsch's array of offensive moves that included drives, mid range jump shots, and jump hooks. Sophomore George Washington also scored 22 points. He hit 50% of his deep shots. George also had 6 rebounds, 2 steals,



and 3 blocks. His three pointer and foul shots in the 4th quarter iced the game. Senior Brayden Daniels played more with his head above the rim than with his feet on the ground. Brayden did the dirty work boxing out and rebounding. He lived in the paint denying the athletic Hardin players rebounds. His half court buzzer beater at half time proved decisive. Daniels finished with 12 points, 8 rebounds, 2 steals, and 2 assists. Conner Haun and Cole Hodge provided dogged toughness as usual. Haun had an athletic tip in during a crucial 2nd half

stretch and finished with 6 points and 5 rebounds. Hodge forced his position on his way to 5 rebounds and 2 points. Neither team led by double digits and there were 11 lead changes. CAL (again) shot greater than 50% for the night. Final Score: **CAL 72 John Hardin 70**

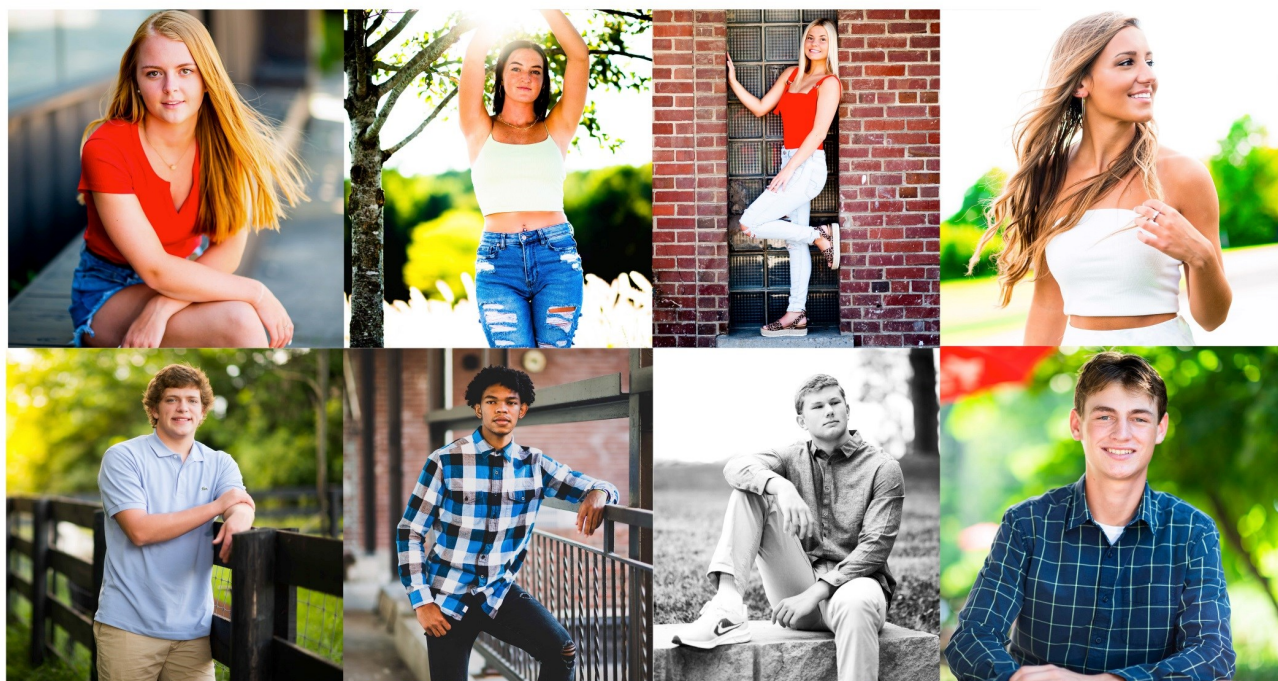
