

VARSITY BOYS BASKETBALL NOTCHES ANOTHER HUGE WIN ENDS JOHN HARDIN'S 36 GAME HOME WINNING STREAK

Conner Haun and Cole Hodge provided dogged toughness as usual. Haun had an athletic tip in during a crucial 2nd half
