February 12, 2021 CAL 65 Seneca 54

Washington went off for 36 points including 10 of 10 from the charity stripe. He shot 71% from the field. Wearsch had 15 points, 9 rebounds, and 2 steals. Daniels had 5 points, 11 rebounds, 2 steals, and 4 assists. Cole Hodge had 6 and 3. CAL beat this big public school while missing two senior starters. Lagestee and Haun were both injured.



February 13, 2021 CAL 72 Central 54



CAL shot 50% from the field (again) en route to beating Central this evening by 18. CAL was missing two starters to injuries again. Washington had a strong game posting 27 points, 8 rebounds, and 6 assists. Luke Erhardt hit four 3 pointers and scored 16. Daniels had a double double with 12 and 11. Wearsch had 12 and 6.

February 19, 2021 CAL 76 Eastern 71

Still down one starter to injury (Haun), CAL scored a major victory over district rival Eastern on February 19. This victory was only CAL's fourth win against Eastern in the last twenty-something contests. CAL shot 54% from the field, 41% from three, and 81% from the stripe. Washington had 28 points and 3 assists. Daniels had 19 points and 3 rebounds. Wearsch had 16 and 11 for another double double.



February 20, 2021 CAL 80 South Oldham 74



South Oldham had beaten us 7 years in a row. But that streak ended last weekend when CAL went to South Oldham and secured a 6 point victory. CAL shot 52% from the field and saw 4 players score in double figures. Washington went off for 35 points and 6 rebounds. Wearsch had 16 points and 4 rebounds. Daniels had another double double with 10 and 10. Erhardt scored 11. Lagestee had 8 points, 4 rebounds, and 5 assists.
