

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

College Preparatory Diploma – 24 credits

2 years of the same foreign language

GPA must be 3.0 weighted

No honors classes required



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Honors Diploma – 24 credits

2 years of the same foreign language

GPA of 3.5 weighted

Three years of honors classes in at least two different subjects




AP WORLD CIVILIZATION

SPANISH

- Start now if you have not had a foreign language
- Must take 2nd year, if you are not currently in foreign language
- Must be the same both years
- Must have for almost all colleges
- Highly selective colleges generally want more than 2 years
