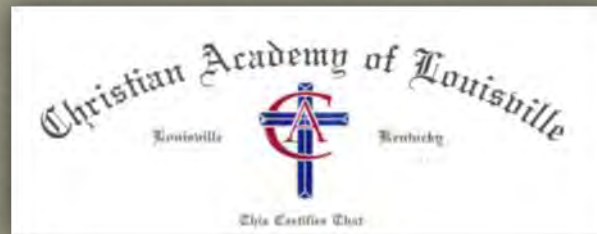
# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

*College Preparatory Diploma – 24 credits*

2 years of the same foreign language

GPA must be 3.0 weighted

No honors classes required



# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

*Honors Diploma – 24 credits*

2 years of the same foreign language

GPA of 3.5 weighted

Three years of honors classes in at least two  
different subjects

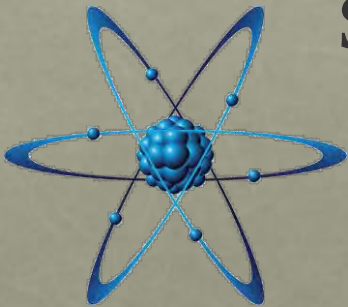

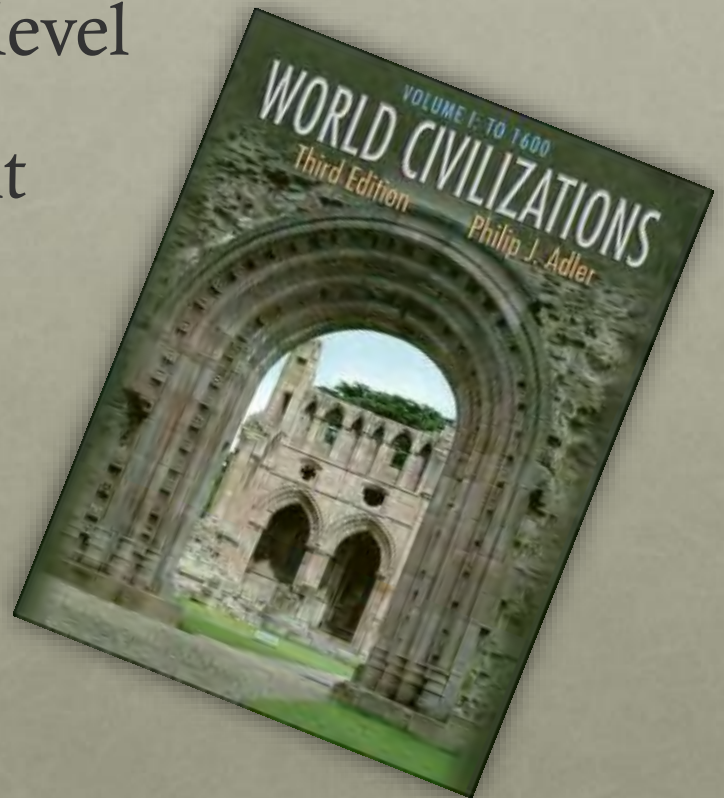

SPANISH

- Start now if you have not had a foreign language
- Must take 2<sup>nd</sup> year, if you are not currently in foreign language
- Must be the **same** both years
- Must have for almost all colleges
- Highly selective colleges generally want more than 2 years
