International Travel Quarantine

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If your student will be traveling internationally over Spring Break, the Indiana Department of Health (ISDH) recommends that schools follow the CDC guidance for quarantining upon return from international travel.

- Get tested 3 -5 days after return from travel **AND** stay home and self-quarantine for 7 days after travel
 - *Even if you test negative, stay home and self-quarantine for the full 7 days.
 - *If your test is positive, isolate yourself for 10 days to protect others from getting infected.
- If you don't get tested, it's safest to stay home and self-quarantine for 10 days after travel.
- Avoid being around people who are at increased risk for severe illness for 14 days, whether you get tested or not.

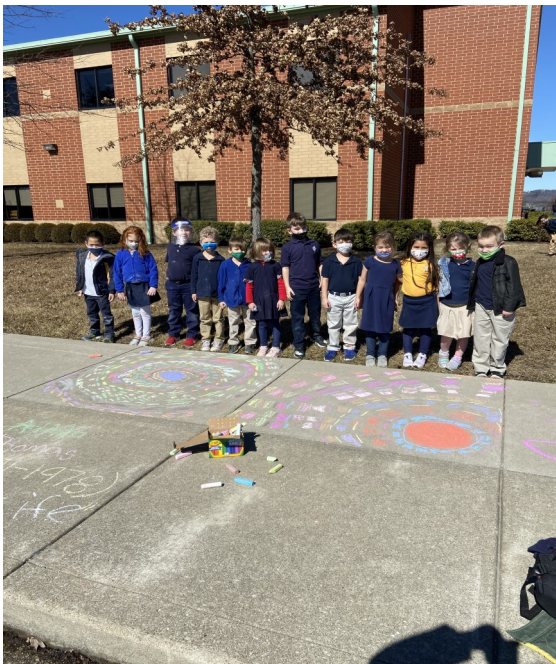
