## Period 1: 1490-1607 European Exploration and the Columbian Exchange

**<u>Key Concept 1</u>**: Before the arrival of Europeans, native populations in North America developed a wide variety of social, political, and economic structures based in part on interactions with the environment and each other.

**Key Concept 2**: Motivated by economic, political and religious developments in European society, Portuguese and Spanish explorers encountered and then conquered much of the Western Hemisphere during the late 15<sup>th</sup> century and throughout the 16<sup>th</sup> century. The clash of cultures that resulted from this European colonization effort and what is known as the Columbian Exchange led to significant changes to the indigenous population of North America.
