Chapel Day Dress Code

Elementary

- Girls-Jumper, skirt, or skort worn with a <u>white</u> <u>collared blouse</u> or approved uniform dress. Navy or white cardigan or navy crew or v-neck sweaters may be worn in cold weather.
- Boys-Khaki or navy uniform pants or shorts with white or light blue oxford shirt and solid navy, gold or teh approved plaid tie or bowtie are required. Navy cardigan, crew, v-neck sweaters may be worn in cold weather.
- Approved sweatshirts and quarter-zip pullovers may not be worn to chapel.

High School/Middle School

Long pants or skirts (no shorts), and a logo button-down oxford or blouse (no polos, sweatshirts, or athletic wear.) Logo sweaters are also permitted. Boys are to wear a tie.

Elementary students

- Boys-Dress shirts or polos with dress pants or school uniform bottoms. No t-shirts or jeans (ties are optional.)
- Girls-Modest dresses no shorter than 2 inches above the knee with sleeves or nice tops with dress pants (no jeans) or skirts no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Leggings may be worn under a dress or skirt, but the dress or skirt must still be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. If a dress or top is sleeveless, it must be worn with a sweater. Girls may wear sandals for their picture, but must bring tennis shoes to change into.


