VARSITY BOYS SOCCER

Last week the Varsity Boys Soccer team started their season off with a game against Lanesville High School. The Warriors suffered a disappointing loss against the Eagles but did not let it affect them for long as they competed in the Jennings County tournament on Friday and Saturday. The boys were looking for a win on Friday evening against Morristown High School. They played the best game the coach has seen in several years. They gave it everything they had for the full game and did not quit! Unfortunately, the game ended in a 0-1 loss.

Saturday, the Warriors had two games, the first against Milan which resulted in a 4-1 win and the second against Jennings County which resulted in a 1-8 loss. Despite this loss, the boys played well considering they played three games in less than 20 hours with only two substitutes. They are looking to build from here and are excited about the season ahead.

VARSITY GIRLS SOCCER

The Lady Warriors played Northeast Debois with a result of 3-0 loss. The girls played very hard with no substitutions and continue to get better everyday!

VARSITY BOYS TENNIS

In the season opener, the Warriors faced the Corydon Panthers. Caleb Huguley, Leyden Pavlica and Hunter Webb made their Varsity debuts at #2 Doubles and #3 Singles, respectively. Though they fell to the Panther's superior offense at the net, Huguley and Pavlica took a game off of each of their more experienced opponents' sets, falling 1-6, 1-6. Webb, in his first ever match, managed to take five games away from Corydon's number three before falling 4-6, 1-6. In #1 Doubles, Ethan Sanders/Myles Morgan nearly swept their competition with gargantuan serves and agile net play, taking the win (6-0, 6-1). A nail biting double feature in #1 and #2 Singles, Nathan Whitten and Tate Hickman (also his varsity debut) broke their well-matched opponents at the tiebreak with aggressive backhands and big serves, winning (6-4, 1-6, 10-8 and 2-6, 6-2, 10-5 respectively). Ultimately the Warriors defeated the Panthers 3-2.

If Monday gave the Warriors some momentum to start, the Pirates gave them some homework. Though the Warriors fought hard for each game, they were overpowered by more experienced opponents. Tate Hickman and Nathan Whitten closely tailed their opponents in the first set before being edged out (3-6, 0-6 and 4-6, 1-6). Leyden Pavlica and Caleb Huguley showed quick footwork and string groundstrokes but also fell to the Pirates (0-6, 1-6). The exception was #1 Doubles (Ethan Sanders/Myles Morgan), where we saw the Warriors pummel the Pirates with blazing service aces and punishing net play.
