

Health & Safety Protocols

2021-2022 School Year

The following chart will serve as a guide to assist school leaders in making decisions about implementing further COVID mitigation strategies.

- Each Christian Academy school will be assessed according to their specific school data and a color designation will be assigned by school. A school's status will be displayed on the COVID information page on the Christian Academy website. www.cashools.us
- The systematic protocols described below are designed to help keep students, families, and staff safe and healthy.
- These actions are adopted using a combination of CDC guidelines, state and county health departments guidelines. This includes wearing a mask at all times while traveling on a school bus.
- Several procedures are contingent upon guidance provided by appropriate public health agencies.

GREEN

The CASS 2021-22 Return to School guidelines included that masks were strongly recommended for unvaccinated individuals but not mandatory.

• **ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOl**--0 to 3 students are COVID positive

Absentee rate of 13% due to combined illness of students within an individual school AND/OR

BLUE

• **ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOl**--4 to 5 students are COVID positive

Start additional sanitizing procedures*Daily sanitize surfaces and objects that are frequently touched*Fog all rooms of a documented case

Absentee rate of 15% due to combined illness of students within an individual school AND/OR

YELLOW

• **ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOl**--6 to 8 students are COVID positive

Continue daily sanitizing*Fog the rooms of positive case & all restrooms Masks required when moving and in identified classes (i.e. Choir)

Absentee rate of 20% due to combined illness of students within an individual school **AND/OR**

ORANGE

• **ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOl**--9 to 10 students are COVID positive

All students & staff will be required to wear masks (close contacts move from 6' to 3')
All surfaces deep cleaned after all activities within the building & classrooms
Daily fogging of rest rooms & classrooms with positive cases.

RED

Absentee rate of over 21% due to combined illness of students within a school
