



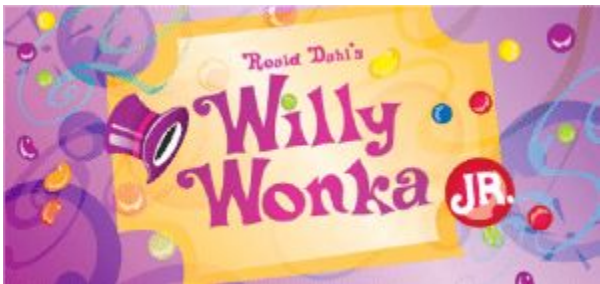

Record Reenrollment

Thank you to everyone who completed your reenrollment for the 2022-23 school year. Over 85% of our current students are enrolled for next school year! This is much higher than we normally are at this point in the year. We are beginning to process new applications, but families can still reenroll at this time through the [FACTS Family Portal](#). Remember our application count is also higher than previous years, and we anticipate having waitlists for many of our grade levels. Since we are open to new applications and the official reenrollment window is closed, there is a risk of grade levels filling up before your child is reenrolled.

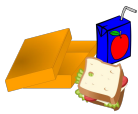

"Right to Life Southern Indiana will be holding its annual Value of Life Competition. Participants in grades 8-12 may participate in the oratory contest. Students will be asked to research, write and present an original pro-life essay for Level I (grades 8-10) and a speech for Level II on abortion, infanticide, euthanasia or stem cell research. There are cash prizes for winners. The competition is open to all students attending school or residing in Clark, Crawford, Floyd and Harrison counties. Please see Mr. Wilson in the counseling office for more information. Deadline to submit entries is Monday, Feb. 21st."

"Each year, the American Legion Auxiliary sponsors an Americanism Essay Contest for students in grades 3-12. Grade levels are divided into six classes, one award is presented in each class. First prize is \$50. This year's title is "How can we address the health and well-being of our veterans, military, and their families". Essays are due with a Cover Sheet March 1, 2022.
