### January 11, 2022



CALMS Swimming ended their season incredibly!

Congratulations to all of our swimmers on an OUTSTANDING meet!!

We only had 9 swimmers for Champs due to illness (5 girls, 4 boys), and finished 6th overall!!!!!!! Our girls swam unbelievable with only 5 swimmers and finished 4th, while our boys also swam great and placed 6th!

There are too many highlights from the meet to list, but I did want to note some things that really stood out to me. I could not be more PROUD of these kids!!!

We had swimmers MEDAL (top 8) six times!!

Amelia Jackson: WON the 50 breaststroke!! Then turned right around the very next event and blasted a GREAT 100 IM to finish 2nd overall!

**Rory Ross:** Crushed the 32.00 mark on the 50 freestyle by swimming 31.60 (a new personal best!) to finish 5th overall!!! Also finished 9th overall in the 50 breast!!



**Kate Gleitz:** Swam an awesome 50 back to finish 8th overall!! Also swam a really solid 100 free to finish 10th overall...and she's only a 6th grader! ;-)

Lanie Wilson: Two top 15 finishes as a 6th grader!! Finished 14th in the 50 free and 15th in the 100 free (cut a full second in the 100)!! Also swam a MONSTER 50 fly on the girls medley relay by going 37.36 to help the girls finish 4th in the relay (almost 3rd!)

Alessia Pino: Just missed a personal best in the 50 free and swam really hard in both individual events. Alessia did great for being new to swimming this season!!

**Jack Borraga:** WON the 100 freestyle in a personal best time of 58.67 seconds! Finished 2nd in the 50 breaststroke and narrowly missed winning as he lost by 0.4 seconds; also swam his fastest 50 breast time in over 18 months at 33.92 seconds!

**Cameron Seidenfaden:** Swam a personal best of 32.46 seconds to finish 4th overall in the 50 back... amazing swim!!Turned right around the very next event and swam a personal best in the 50 fly of 32.13 seconds to finish 5th overall!

**Eli Vandervelden:** Swam 2 per sonal bests (!) in both the 50 free and 50 back! Eli broke the 36 second barrier in the 50 free by going 35.91! He CRUSHED his personal best to leadoff the medley relay with a 42.77 second back-stroke, which was critical in helping the boys relay to a 6th place finish!

**Willett Brooks:** Willett smashed his 50 back per sonal best by nearly 2 seconds (!!) by going 48.61 to finish 34th out of 70 swimmers! Also incredible, he swam two amazing freestyle legs on both relays!!! In the medley relay, Willett swam so fast (38.97 seconds!!) on the anchor free that I had to double check his time. He had never been below 41 seconds in a 50 free, and he went below 39 at the most crucial time, with all of the pressure in anchoring the boys medley relay.



Thank you so much again for an amazing season! I sincerely hope to see all of you back for next season (for those that return to middle school).

And I certainly wish our 8th graders Rory and Cameron the best going forward. You will be truly missed!!!!!!
