Times are approximate, depending on traffic conditions. Due to road, traffic & weather conditions, please have your child at the bus stop at least 5 minutes early. **Exact location of bus stops** within the parking lots is at the discretion of the bus driver based upon local conditions and safety considerations. There can be no stops other than those listed.

The school alert system is used to communicate delays and schedule changes.

Daily Service Bus Cost

One student in family	\$105 per month	\$ 75 per month
2 or more students in family	\$140 per month	\$105 per month

- ▶ Bus fee is due on or before the first of each month, August through May.
- ▶ A \$10.00 late charge will be assessed for payments not received as scheduled.
- ▶ Bus service will be suspended for accounts two months past due.
- ▶ In the event your student withdraws from daily bus service, your monthly payments will continue until the Business Office is notified and bus tag is returned.

Occasional Service

If space is available, occasional bus riders may pay \$5 per ride and must obtain a pass from the School Office PRIOR to riding the bus. Passes may be purchased in advance and billed through FACTS Tuition Management. Passes expire at the end of each school year and are non-refundable. Student gives pass to driver when boarding the bus.

PARENTS OF OCCASIONAL RIDERS MUST REGISTER THROUGH FACTS FAMILY PORTAL TO USE BUS SERVICE. REGISTRATION MAY BE COMPLETED ONCE AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT THE ENTIRE YEAR.

BUS RULES

Our chief concern on the school bus is to ensure the safety of each rider. If the driver is being distracted by a discipline problem, he may be endangering all of the students. For this reason, we give our strong support to the rules the bus company requests each rider observe:

1. Bus ID tags should be **visibly** attached to purse or backpack.
2. Cooperate with and respect the driver.
3. Observe the same conduct rules as in the classroom.
4. Do not eat or drink on the bus.
5. Do not use cell phones or other electronic devices on the bus.
6. No animals are permitted on the bus.
7. Keep the bus clean.
8. Stay in your seat.
9. Keep head, hands and feet inside bus.
