## School Supply List Grades 8/High School

Sturdy lockers shelves are not required but they are recommended as they will help students stay organized. Elective courses such as art, band and choir may have additional supply needs, which will be detailed in class. Any supplies issued by the school which are lost or damaged will need to be replaced by students.

### Grade 8

Black/blue pens (English)  
One package red pens (English)  
#2 pencils (1 or 2 large packages)  
One large eraser  
One package of at least 12 colored pencils (Spanish)  
Highlighter markers (green, blue, yellow) (English)  
One package of colored markers for (Spanish)  
Pencil case  
Ruler  
Notebook paper (2 large packages)  
Two boxes of tissues  
Dividers for binder (English)  
One/two inch 3-ring binder w/pockets, filled with notebook paper (English)  
Bible (NIV is a good option because that is the version we use for memory verses. Some type of study Bible would be best to have, especially because we do use the notes and introductions.)  
Spiral notebooks (Bible, history, Spanish)  
One full package of notebook paper (math)  
One paper grocery bag (math)  
Two composition notebooks (English)  
One package of markers (English)  
One small box of crayons (English, Bible)  
Two pocket folders (Spanish, Bible)  
One bottle of glue  
One double-pocket folder (Bible)  
One heavy duty 3-ring 1" binder (math)

Algebra 1 students - T183 or T184 calculator-any model (math)

Pre-Algebra students - TI - 30X IIS -Be careful there is another calculator with a similar number. (math)

### High School

Non-mechanical pencils  
Blue/black ink pens  
Notebook paper (not spiral)  
Organizational materials (binders, folders)

Individual courses may also require supplies that are specific to that course; these will be detailed by the teacher and listed on the Course Overview.

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Additional supplies may be provided by teachers; any supplies issued by the school which are lost or damaged will need to be replaced by students.

### AP Class Fees

High school Advanced Placement (AP) classes require fees for the AP exams, which are taken at the conclusion of the course; this is how students are able to earn college credit for the courses. AP courses are \$100 each. These fees will be invoiced through FACTS Tuition, our tuition payment system. We realize that students often make changes to their schedules during the first couple of weeks of school, so charges will not be invoiced to your account until the end of August.
