- 3. 2022-23 Student Demographic (Update in FACTS Family Portal). Please look at ALL of the information, make changes and add information wherever possible. Does your child have a cell phone? If yes, it is VERY helpful if you add this information, especially for retreat and field trips! Make sure you type in your Authorization Signature and *on the left, hit SAVE*.

Daily Information

We are on a 4-block schedule and school begins Wednesday, August 10. The bell rings at 8:20 a.m. and dismissal is at 3:10 p.m. High School Chapel is on Thursdays. Our first chapel of the 2022-2023 school year will be on Thursday, August 18. A chapel uniform is required.

Carpool for High School - The speed limit on school property is 15 mph; please abide by this to help keep everyone safe. Please refer to the <u>High School Handbook</u> for arrival/dismissal information. Parents, please do not park or pick up in the Upperclassmen Parking Lot but follow the carpool directions that will be communicated prior to the start of school.

Student Parking - An annual permit is required and all drivers must apply for their 2022-2023 car tag. Student Parking is on a first-come, first-to-park basis in the front lot. Parking begins as soon as you turn right off the main driveway and continues across to the football entrance. Students park in spots with NO numbers. If there is a number on the spot, it is assigned faculty parking and you will receive a \$10 fine. If in doubt, come to the office and we will clarify. Parents, please do not park or pick up in the Student Parking Lot but follow the carpool directions that will be communicated prior to the start of school. A <u>Student Parking Application</u> must be completed if your child already has their license and will be parking on campus. Print a hard copy of the form, sign it and bring it in on Registration Day. A \$25 student parking fee will be billed through FACTS Tuition in September or throughout the school year as needed. We take security on campus seriously and every vehicle that parks on campus must be registered annually.

Visitor Lot - We have a visitor lot on the left as you enter the campus. Students are not allowed to park in the visitor lot.

Dress Code

All garments must have a traditional fit; oversized or excessively tight styles are not permitted. Uniform items such as skirts, oxfords and polos must be purchased through our two approved suppliers listed below. Our suppliers are aware of CAL's uniform requirements. For further information, please refer to our High School Handbook and check out the dress code. Be advised that the dress code will be checked on the first day of school and we expect all students to be compliant. This includes all dress code expectations in the handbook...boy's shorts/hair length, girl's skirt length and approved footwear.

IMMUNIZATIONS UP TO DATE? They must be completed and received to get your schedule!

- All students 16 years of age and older (this includes summer birthdays) need to have a Meningococcal Booster shot (some students have already done this but many have not).
- Any student needing the second Hepatitis A shot in the 2 shot series.
- O Any new high school students or any new high school students from last school year who have not already done so need a current immunization certificate that includes a physician's signature and expiration date, a preventative health care examination form (NOT a sports physical) and a photocopy of a state-issued birth certificate.
