BACK-TO-SCHOOL DROP-IN

Your child will not receive a schedule, locker assignment (middle school), Chromebook or may not be able to start school without the proper documentation on file which includes immunizations.

<u>Required FACTS Family Portal Documents to Complete by July 27</u> (in <u>FACTS Family Portal</u>, click School and click Web Forms). They should be completed on a computer and not via your smart phone or tablet device.
