ARRIVAL

For **arrival**, there is now only one route.

DISMISSAL

For **dismissal**, there are three routes:

Choose the **one** that applies to your family.

- 1. If you have only elementary students.
- 2. If you have elementary + middle/high school students.
- 3. If you have middle and/or high school students.

To help make things safer and faster, we ask these things:

- 1. Please do not drop off/pick up students in unapproved areas, such as the visitor parking lot, front of school, or adjoining neighborhoods. As these practices create safety risks, the school will follow a zero tolerance policy for offenders. For *repeat* offenders, the school will issue monetary fines and disciplinary consequences.
- 2. Please do not cut through an adjoining neighborhood unless you live there or are picking up someone who lives there. We want to be good neighbors.
- 3. When exiting from the main exit, please do not turn left from 7:15 to 8:15 and from 2:30 to 3:30, when traffic cones indicate a right turn, or when carlines exist. Turning left creates the potential for a serious accident, and it slows the line for everyone.

(Printable One-Pager) ARRIVAL (Updated 08/10/2022)

All carpool drivers should follow the red line around the athletic fields and school building. Drop off all students where indicated on the elementary side.

Please do not drop off students anywhere other than the yellow highlighted area on the elementary side.



By staging cars around the athletic fields and school building, we take up to 220 cars off the public roads, which makes us safer and helps our neighbors.

PLEASE DO NOT:


- Drop off students in unapproved areas, such as the visitor parking lot.
- Drop off students on public roads/neighborhoods and have them walk to school.
- Drive on the wrong side of the road, especially coming up the main entrance.

DISMISSAL: IF YOU HAVE ONLY ELEMENTARY STUDENT(S)

Follow the **red** line around the athletic fields and school building. Pick up where indicated on the elementary side (same pick-up location for elementary as last year).

Please display your school-issued carpool number clearly in the window (not flat on the dash).



PLEASE DO NOT:

- Pick up students in unapproved areas, such as the visitor parking lot.
- Pick up students on public roads or in adjoining neighborhoods.
- Drive on the wrong side of the road, especially coming up the main entrance.

DISMISSAL: IF YOU HAVE ELEM + MIDDLE/HIGH STUDENTS

Follow the **red** line around the athletic fields. Then split off into the gray (inside) line. Pick up your elementary and middle/high student(s) together in the **red** gym circle.

Please display your school-issued carpool number clearly in the window (not flat on the dash).

Please encourage your older children to help your younger children as appropriate.




PLEASE DO NOT:

- Pick up students in unapproved areas, especially the visitor parking lot.
- Pick up students on public roads or in adjoining neighborhoods.
- Drive on the wrong side of the road, especially coming up the main entrance.

DISMISSAL: IF YOU HAVE ONLY MIDDLE/HIGH STUDENTS

Follow the blue line and pick up Middle and High School students at the blue gym.

Please display your school-issued carpool number clearly in the window (not flat on the dash).



PLEASE DO NOT:

- Pick up students in unapproved areas, especially the visitor parking lot.
- Pick up students on public roads or in adjoining neighborhoods.
- Drive on the wrong side of the road, especially coming up the main entrance.
