- Funded new elementary counselor positions



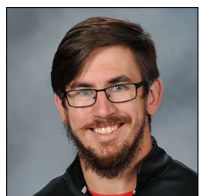
# OUTSTANDING TEACHERS

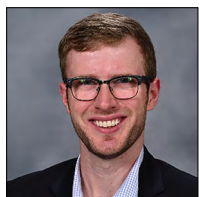
**JULIE CHASE, *English Station Elementary***

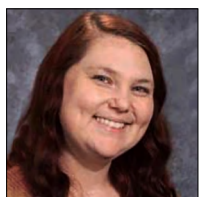
**TY BARNETT, *English Station Middle School***
