

College Representatives

Christian Academy of Indiana is happy to provide our Juniors and Seniors with many opportunities to meet college representatives on our campus to learn more about what various colleges and universities have to offer. These visits will be scheduled throughout September and October. In order to participate, students need to be a part of the College Rep Visits 2022 course in Canvas. You should have received an invitation in August. Students will also need to sign up for the visit under the Module for the college or university. You will not be excused from class unless you have signed up for the visit. Sign-ups will close at 8:15 on the morning of the visit and students (and their teachers) will be notified by email of their assigned time.

Students will be scheduled in groups of 3 - 5 students to visit with the representative. The sessions will last no longer than 15 - 20 minutes to minimize the amount of time out of class. Representatives will provide written material about their college and may request contact information from the students to send more information. Students should do some research ahead of the visit in order to be prepared with questions for the representatives. Links to the schools will be added to the Canvas course for easy reference.
