Varsity volleyball picked up two more wins this week with victories over Austin and New Washington with their only loss of the week coming at the hands of 4A Jeffersonville. The win over Austin saw junior Karlyn Denny return to the lineup for the first time in a week. Denny led the Warriors with eight kills.

Thursday night at Jeffersonville the Warriors struggled in serve receive most of the night and were unable to get into a rhythm offensively. Sophomore Avery Kerr led the team with five kills while sophomores Kristen Abbott and Leah Stevens defensively picked up 12 and 11 digs, respectively. The Warriors finished off the week with a win Friday night at New Washington. Kerr picked up her first double-double of the season (10 aces / 10 kills) while also recording a season high hitting percentage of 0.563. Abbott made the transition to libero and recorded a team high on the night with 12 digs.
