



A MESSAGE FROM MRS. CARSON

Welcome to fall! We are so blessed to have our school rest at the bottom of a beautiful hillside. Just one of God's many blessings. Congratulations on completing Quarter 1 of the school year! Another blessing is being in school for a whole quarter! With fall comes different temperatures, less daylight, and a great time for some reminders.

Remember parents, keep your demographic information current in FACTS. This includes phone numbers, email addresses, and emergency contact information. You simply go into FACTS to your Web Forms to verify and edit.

Carpool safety: Morning dropoff—pull all the way up and have students ready to exit the car. Cell phones should not be used for the safety of the students, and final conversations are invaluable. Students need to exit their car when they are able to exit and walk to the door on the sidewalk (there is no time for everyone to pull up to the very front and exit.) Afternoon dismissal— hug a bumper but don't touch it--this allows the optimum number of cars to be in the zone for pick up. We like for students to enter vehicles between the main entrance crosswalk and the playground crosswalk.

Communication: Please call or email your child's teacher and the office regarding absences, appointments, or early dismissals/late arrivals.

Dress code: Review the handbook dress code guidelines for leggings, shoes, and outerwear. Uniform guidelines vary in elementary and middle school, so please review for colder weather. No boots in elementary school.

Punctuality: Being on time is a win/win for all parties at school. Although it will be darker longer and sooner, adjust your morning and evening routines to arrive on time for school.

Safety drills: are monthly and include evacuation, fire, severe weather, and intruder. Students are to be prepared and not scared. This is good to discuss at home and have a plan for home as well.

Safety reminders: Anyone on campus must check-in and have an ID for our Raptor system and nothing that gives the appearance or sound of a weapon should be brought to school. Safety concerns can always be directed to our Anonymous Tip Line at 502-400-8525 or security@caschools.us.

Traffic: Respect and follow the traffic officer's directions for coming on and off campus. Give full attention to the officer's directions.




