Junior quarterback Cole Hodge completed ten passes on 11 attempts for 200 yards and six touchdowns. Sophomore Trey Cotton caught five passes for 100 yards receiving and three touchdowns. Junior Malachi Embers caught two passes for 63 yards and two touchdowns, and senior Gunnar McKinley caught one pass for a touchdown.

Senior Gavin Copenhaver led the team on the ground, rushing for 51 yards and a touchdown on nine carries. Senior Jaylen McRoberts had four carries for 24 yards, and junior Reed Jeffries rushed for 13 yards and a touchdown on three carries.



Defensively, the Centurion defense had 34 tackles, including four tackles for a loss of yards. Senior linebacker Gavin Copenhaver led the team in tackles with five, followed by senior Nate Heidenreich, senior McKade Battcher, and junior Nate Ehrenborg, who each had three tackles. In addition, Nate Heidenreich had an interception, returning it for 21 yards, and junior Alex Ullom forced and recovered a fumble.

The Centurions face the Elizabethtown Panthers in the second round of the KHSAA Class 3A championship playoffs this Friday night, 7:30

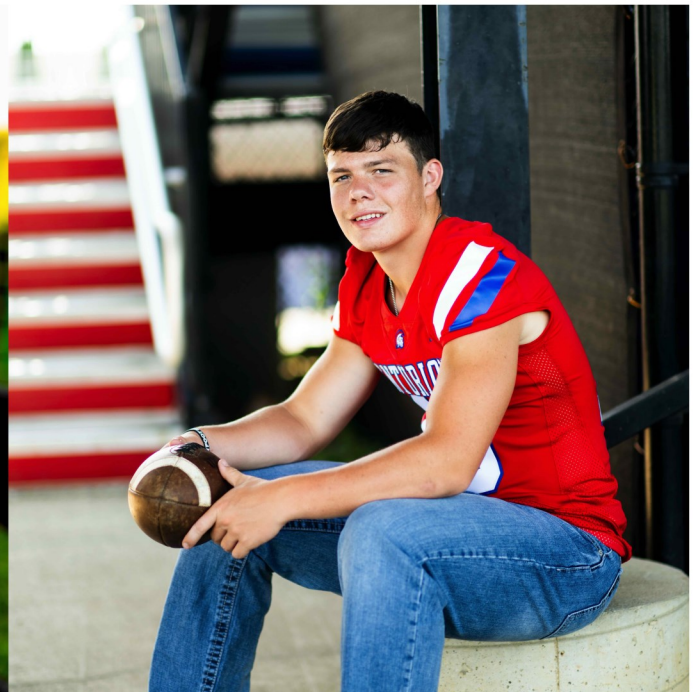
