CHANGE THE USA FOR CHRIST WEEK IS MARCH 27-31

Change the USA for Christ will take place March 27-31! Students will be able to change their outward appearance for the week as a reminder that we each need to change on the inside. In the gospel of Jesus Christ, we are given the promise that anyone who comes to Christ in faith will have an internal change take place - i.e. the changing from a heart of stone to a heart of flesh (cf. Ezekiel 36:26-27). Each day students will pay one dollar to dress out (students may pay five dollars on Monday to cover the week). All money collected will go to support the Jackson family who serves as missionaries in Asia.


