# SECOND QUARTER SERVICE PROJECT

We are packing and collecting shoebox gifts for Operation Christmas Child! Your child should have received a brochure with instructions and details for how to pack a shoebox gift. The deadline to turn in these gifts is Thursday, November 17, as part of National Collection Week for Operation Christmas Child. We will have a special chapel service on Thursday, November 17 at 9:00 AM in our gym to collect our shoebox gifts and pray over them. Parents and grandparents are invited to join us for this chapel ser-

vice. All guests will need to enter through the main school entrance (Door #1) at 8:45 AM and have their driver's license with them to receive a visitor's badge.

Last year, our Southwest campus gave 331 shoebox gifts to this ministry and helped to share the Gospel in 10 different countries! Our goal this year is 300 SHOEBOX GIFTS! Our students have already shown so much excitement about this project, and we can't wait to see how the Lord will work through our efforts. If you would like to find out the specific country that your shoebox gift will be shipped to, please use the "Follow Your Box" tracking option that was included in each shoebox. When you pay your \$10 shipping donation online, you are able to enter your email address to receive tracking updates regarding your gifts as they make their way across the world! PLEASE NOTE—Every child who donates a shoebox gift will have their name put in a drawing for a free ticket to Kentucky Kingdom! We will draw winners from preschool, elementary, and middle school. The number of entries for a child's name will equal the number of shoeboxes that the child turns in (ex. 3 shoebox gifts equals 3 times entered in the drawing). - 2. Wait for confirmation on your successful background check (Background check is good for the current school year)
- 3. Once you receive confirmation of a successful background check, you will be emailed a link to sign-up. This will allow you to pick the date that you are wanting to volunteer (limited to one day per school year).
- 4. After you sign-up to volunteer, you will be required to complete a short training session that includes a video series
- 5. On the date that you choose to volunteer on, you will receive a schedule and go through a quick check-in with the Assistant Principal, or another designated Southwest staff member.


