# **Teacher Assignments**

Completion of all "Web Forms" found in FACTS Family Portal serves as our primary source of information about your child so please be thorough.

You must complete your REQUIRED WEB FORMS by July 25, in order to receive your teacher assignment. This includes health room documents required for <u>new and kindergarten families</u>. Once you have fully completed your Web Forms and turned in any needed documents, you will receive an email with your teacher assignment. This will be sent on August 2, 2023.

#### **Meet and Greet Day**

This is when students and parents visit the school to meet their teachers, turn in forms, drop off supplies and pick up any necessary information. Teachers will send a link to "SignUpGenius," an online reservation form, to sign up for a time slot to visit the classroom. The hours will be 8 a.m. - 12 p.m. There will only be a few families visiting at a time so that the teacher can give you the attention that you deserve and begin to build a relationship with your family.

## **Drop Off/Carpool**

The First Day of School is <u>Tuesday</u>, August 8. Chapel is normally on <u>Tuesday</u> but there will not be Chapel on the first day of school so students will <u>not</u> need to wear their chapel uniform. <u>ALL</u> students should be dropped off in the elementary carpool line by 7:45 a.m. Classroom instruction begins at 7:50 a.m. <u>Parents may not enter the building during this time.</u> Staff will be available to assist students as they enter school. We will ensure that all students reach their classrooms and have a great start to the day. Carpool maps and carpool tags will be provided in the back-to-school packet given to each student on their scheduled Meet and Greet Day.

## Kindergarten Schedule for the First Week of School

Please note that kindergarten students attend for a half-day on Tuesday, August 8; Wednesday, August 9; Thursday, August 10. Dismissal on these days, for kindergarten students only, will begin at 11:45 a.m. from the elementary carpool line. This serves several purposes - it eases the students into the routine and shortens a long day while also giving us the opportunity to train them in carpool procedures. All students, including kindergarten, will <a href="Stay a FULL DAY">Stay a FULL DAY</a> on Friday, August 11.

This modified schedule is for the first week of school only.
