ROAD TO THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

CAL FOOTBALL ADVANCES TO NEXT ROUND OF PLAYOFFS

The CAL Varsity football team advanced to the third round of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association Class AAA Football championship playoffs this past Friday night after a victory over the Panthers from Elizabethtown High School. Although the Panthers led the Centurions, 7-6, early in the first quarter, the Centurions quickly cast aside any concerns and dominated Elizabethtown for the remainder of the game. For the eleventh time this season, the Centurions led by a large enough point margin to initiate the running-clock mercy rule, making for a quick second half and ultimate defeat of the Panthers, with a final score of 46-7.



Junior quarterback Cole Hodge was perfect on the night, completing 12 of 12 passes for 221 yards and two touchdowns. Freshman quarterback Colin Daniels stepped in and was also perfect on the night, completing two of two passes for eleven yards. Sophomore Trey Cotton had a huge night receiving, gaining 127 yards and a touchdown. Seniors Gavin Copenhaver and Gunnar McKinley assisted the receiving corps with two significant first-down completions by Gunnar McKinley and a 42-yard touchdown reception by Gavin Copenhaver. Gavin Copenhaver also led the team on the ground, rushing for 93 yards and three touchdowns on 11 carries. On five occasions, quarterback Cole Hodge kept the ball, rushing for 68 yards and a touchdown. Freshman Jeffrey Vazzana also rushed for a touchdown.



The Centurion defense held Elizabethtown to just 59 yards rushing and 44 yards receiving, with 49 total tackles, including nine tackles for a loss of yards and a quarterback sack. Senior Isaac Patrick led the team in tackles with 10, followed by seniors Nate Heidenreich, McKade Batcher, and Sam McCoun, who each had seven. Gavin Copenhaver had five tackles, including a sack and two tackles for a loss of yards. Senior Braden Robinson had four tackles, followed by Gunnar McKinley and Trey Cotton with three tackles. Trey Cotton also assisted the defense with a key interception in the second quarter.



The Centurions now face Paducah-Tilghman in the third round of the KHSAA Class 3A championship playoffs. Paducah-Tilghman ended CAL's season early last year, defeating them in the third round. It was a loss that this year's team remembers well and is determined not to repeat this Friday night, 7:30 pm, at CAL.
