

CENTURION BASEBALL CLOSES REGULAR SEASON, START DISTRICT PLAYOFFS THIS WEEK

CAL baseball closed out their regular season schedule on Saturday as they turn their focus on their District playoffs on May 15 against Eastern. In the final week of games, CAL would close out their final regular season game as they traveled to DeSales to play the Colts. CAL's offense would put pressure on the DeSales defense early with singles in the first inning by Nathan King, and in the second inning with singles by Bradey Moad, Ryan Lynch, and Andrew Gilliam to load the bases for the Centurions with one out. CAL would be unable to push across a score as the game was still score-less after the top half of the second inning. Cameron Combs would lead off the 3rd inning with a single, but again the Centurions would continue to fail to score and trail at





the end of the 3rd inning 2-0. CAL would push into the top of the 5th inning trailing 6-0, and the Centurion offense would put some runs on the board. Gilliam would open the 5th inning with a hit by pitch, and Trey Tipton would draw a walk to find Centurions at first and second. After a successful sacrifice bunt by Sam Zeller, Combs would single to push in Gilliam for the score. King would draw a walk to load up the bases again for the Centurions. Noah McCarty would clear the bases on a triple to center field and CAL would only trail by two. Avery Hare would double to right field that would draw the Centurions to within one run, 6-5. 

The Colonels bus was late to the game, but the Colonel bats came in early. CAL would find themselves in an early deficit heading into the bottom of the 2nd inning. CAL would load up



the bases against the Colonels with a single by Moad and Gilliam and a walk by Zeller. CAL would strand the runners and still looking for the first score for the home team. CAL would take advantage of four consecutive



walks (Gilliam, Kaden Crawford, Zeller, and Tipton) along with a wild pitch to get the initial two runs for CAL. 


