Results of one or both tests may be required for admission to most institutions of higher learning. Students are encouraged to take entrance exams at least twice. Free SAT Bootcamp for students

Khan Academy is offering free online tutoring for students taking the SAT in November and December through [Schoolhouse.world](https://www.schoolhouse.world)

- **What are the SAT Bootcamps?** The Schoolhouse.world SAT Bootcamps are a four-week long tutoring series and research study to help students prepare for the upcoming SAT. Sessions take place twice a week (75 minutes per session) and students have the flexibility to select the dates and times that best fit their schedule based on the bootcamps available.
- **What is covered?** Students will learn from a certified peer tutor in a cohort of up to 10 other students throughout the bootcamp. During sessions, students will practice multiple full length SAT practice tests and get personalized support for the most challenging questions and concepts.
- **When will they be held?** Bootcamps consist of two sessions per week. The November SAT Bootcamp will be held from Saturday, October 8, through Friday, November 4, and the December SAT Bootcamp will be held from Saturday, November 5, through Friday, December 2.
