ACT/SAT

- Take with **entire** junior class at CAL April 23rd
- Register NOW for a test, online (There are only 3 tests left before your senior year -- April 13th, June 8th, and July 13th)
- Take the test *again* your senior year depending on situation and reason
- May want to take a prep class after your first test (i.e. try using Method Learning and myact.org)
- Include your SSN when you register for the test
- Register for the SAT online at collegeboard.org
(Test dates before and during senior year – May 4th, June 1st, August 24th, October 5th and November 2nd)

- It helps to "stay in the groove"

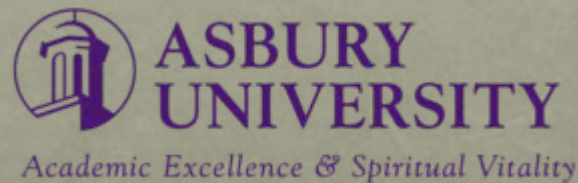


Advanced Placement

Dual Enrollment (DE)

- Be aware of minimum GPA
- May be able to use KEES Scholarship
- ACT – A minimum composite score with a certain sub-score in the subject area that corresponds with the high school dual credit course may be required, or
- PSAT – composite score may be required in a certain percentile
