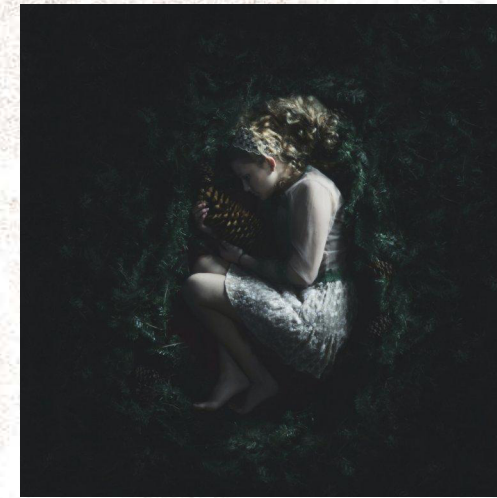
Art students at the English Station campus of Christian Academy School System were awarded 50 Scholastic Arts Awards on Feb. 20, 2015 at the Louisville Metropolitan Region Student Art Awards Ceremony.

“This is the largest art competition in the world with more than 300,000 students competing. It is such an honor for our students to have their work selected for 17 Honorable Mentions, 18 Silver Keys, 14 Gold Keys, 1 American Visionary Nomination and 1 National Silver Medal.”, art teacher Tammy Cusick said. “Our students are gifted artists and work throughout their high school art career to assemble a quality portfolio including these pieces.”

Each year, the art program is focused on building the strength of each individual class because each class is unique. Cusick focuses their attention on learning and improving their strengths.

For 13 years, Cusick was the middle school art teacher and is currently in her sixth year at the high school level. She said the art program continues to grow and anticipates even more students next year.

“In our upper levels we discuss art and learn to critique art well. Students give and take honest criticism and feedback, helping each other improve their art,” Cusick said.

## The Breakdown

**Gold Key:** The highest level of achievement on the regional level. Approximately 7 – 10% of all regional submissions are recognized with Gold Key Awards and all are considered for national-level recognition.

**Silver Key:** Approximately 10 – 15% of all regional submissions are recognized with Silver Key Awards.

**Honorable Mention:** This Award recognizes students with artistic potential. Approximately 15 – 20% of all regional submissions receive Honorable Mention Awards.
